## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the optional flexible school day program provided by
- 3 school districts.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 29.0822(a), Education Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Notwithstanding Section 25.081 or 25.082, a school
- 8 district may apply to the commissioner to provide a flexible school
- 9 day program for [students who]:
- 10 (1) students who have dropped out of school or are at
- 11 risk of dropping out of school as defined by Section 29.081;
- 12 (2) <u>students who</u> attend a campus that is implementing
- 13 an innovative redesign of the campus or an early college high school
- 14 under a plan approved by the commissioner; [er]
- 15 (3) students who, as a result of attendance
- 16 requirements under Section 25.092, will be denied credit for one or
- 17 more classes in which the students have been enrolled; or
- 18 (4) a campus or campuses that would benefit from the
- 19 program.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2013-2014
- 21 school year.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
