- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 508, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 508.1491 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 508.1491. MANDATORY SUPERVISION FOR CERTAIN OFFENSES
- 8 INVOLVING POSSESSION OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE. Sections
- 9 508.149(b), (c), and (d) do not apply to an inmate serving a
- 10 sentence for a third degree felony offense under Section 481.115,
- 11 481.1151, 481.116, 481.1161, 481.117, 481.118, or 481.121, Health
- 12 and Safety Code.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to any
- 14 inmate serving a term of imprisonment in a facility operated by or
- 15 under contract with the Texas Department of Criminal Justice on or
- 16 after the effective date of this Act, regardless of when the inmate
- 17 was sentenced to serve that term.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
