- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 86.011, Election Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 7 (e) This subsection applies only to an election held in a
- 8 county with a population of 20,000 or more in which a federal office
- 9 appears on the ballot. The early voting clerk shall make the unique
- 10 identification number described by Section 86.013(h) available on
- 11 the county's website and indicate whether the return of the
- 12 <u>official carrier envelope associated with the number is timely.</u>
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 86.013, Election Code, is amended by
- 14 adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 15 (h) This subsection applies only to an election held in a
- 16 county with a population of 20,000 or more in which a federal office
- 17 appears on the ballot. The secretary of state by rule shall require
- 18 that a detachable receipt be attached to the official carrier
- 19 envelope and a unique identification number be printed on the
- 20 receipt and the reverse side of the envelope.
- SECTION 3. Sections 86.011(e) and 86.013(h), Election Code,
- 22 as added by this Act, apply only to an election ordered on or after
- 23 September 1, 2013.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
