- 2 relating to notice requirements for emergency services districts.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 775.015(e), Health and Safety Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (e) Not later than the 21st day before the date on which the
- 7 hearing will be held, the sheriff shall post one copy of the notice
- 8 at the courthouse door. The sheriff shall also have the notice
- 9 published in a regional or area-specific publication [newspaper of
- 10 general circulation] in the proposed district once a week for two
- 11 consecutive weeks. The first publication must occur not later than
- 12 the 21st day before the date on which the hearing will be held.
- SECTION 2. Section 775.036(f), Health and Safety Code, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- 15 (f) Each January, the board shall publish the street address
- 16 of the district's administrative office in a regional or
- 17 <u>area-specific publication</u> [eight-point type in the legal notices
- 18 section of a newspaper of general circulation] in the district. In a
- 19 district's first year of operation, the board shall publish the
- 20 notice not later than the 60th day after the date the initial board
- 21 is appointed.
- SECTION 3. Section 775.051(d), Health and Safety Code, is
- 23 amended to read as follows:
- 24 (d) The secretary shall:

- 1 (1) post copies of the notice in three public places in
- 2 the district and one public place in the territory proposed to be
- 3 annexed into the district for at least 15 days before the date of
- 4 the hearing; and
- 5 (2) not later than the 16th day before the date on
- 6 which the hearing will be held, publish the notice once in a
- 7 regional or area-specific publication [newspaper of general
- 8 circulation] in the county.
- 9 SECTION 4. Section 775.052(d), Health and Safety Code, is
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 (d) The notice shall be published in a <u>regional or</u>
- 12 area-specific publication [newspaper of general circulation] in
- 13 the district once a week for two consecutive weeks. The first
- 14 publication must occur not later than the 21st day before the date
- 15 on which the hearing will be held.
- SECTION 5. Section 775.0745(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 (b) Subject to Section 4.003, Election Code, the [The] board
- 19 shall give notice of the election in the same manner as the notice
- 20 of petition hearing described by Section 775.015 [as provided by
- 21 Section 4.003, Election Code]. The notice shall contain the
- 22 information required by Section 4.004, Election Code.
- SECTION 6. Section 775.077(c), Health and Safety Code, is
- 24 amended to read as follows:
- 25 (c) The board shall publish notice of the election at least
- 26 once in a regional or area-specific publication [newspaper of
- 27 general circulation] in the district. The notice must be published

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- 1 not later than the 31st day before election day.
- 2 SECTION 7. Section 775.084(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 (b) The board shall request bids on items to be purchased or
- 5 leased or services to be performed as provided by this subsection.
- 6 The board shall notify suppliers, vendors, or providers by
- 7 advertising for bids or by providing at least three suppliers,
- 8 vendors, or purchasers with written notice by mail of the intended
- 9 purchase. If the board decides to advertise for bids, the
- 10 advertisement must be published in a regional or area-specific
- 11 publication [accordance with Section 262.025(a), Local Government
- 12 Code]. If the board receives fewer than three bids in response to
- 13 the advertisement, the board shall give written notice directly to
- 14 at least three suppliers, vendors, or providers of the intended
- 15 purchase. If three suppliers, vendors, or providers are not
- 16 available or known to the board, the board shall give written notice
- 17 by mail directly to each supplier, vendor, or provider known to the
- 18 board.
- 19 SECTION 8. Section 775.203(c), Health and Safety Code, is
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- 21 (c) The secretary shall:
- 22 (1) post copies of the notice for at least 15 days
- 23 before the date of the hearing in three public places in the
- 24 district, one of which must be in the territory proposed to be
- 25 excluded; and
- 26 (2) not later than the 16th day before the date on
- 27 which the hearing is held, publish the notice once in a regional or

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- 1 <u>area-specific publication</u> [newspaper of general circulation] in
- 2 each county in which the excluded territory is located.
- 3 SECTION 9. Section 775.222(e), Health and Safety Code, is
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 (e) The board shall publish the notice in a <u>regional or</u>
- 6 <u>area-specific publication</u> [newspaper of general circulation] in
- 7 the district once a week for two consecutive weeks. The first
- 8 publication must occur not later than the 21st day before the date
- 9 on which the hearing will be held.
- 10 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
