H.B. No. 283

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the compensation of county auditors for certain
3 counties.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 152.032(d), Local Government Code, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 (d) The amount of the compensation and allowances of a
8 county auditor in a county subject to this subsection may be set in
9 an amount that exceeds the limit established by Subsection (a) if
10 the compensation and allowances are approved by the commissioners
11 court of the county. This subsection applies only to:

12 (1) a county with a population of more than 108,000 and
13 less than 110,000;

14 (2) a county with a population of 120,000 or more,
15 excluding a county subject to Subsection (b);

16 (3) a county with a population of more than 1,000 and
17 less than 23,000 that borders the Gulf of Mexico; and

18 (4) a county that:

19 (A) borders a county with a population of more
20 than one million; [~~subject to Subsection (b)~~] and

21 (B) [~~that~~] has a population of more than 36,000
22 [~~108,000~~] and less than 40,000 [~~110,000~~].

23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
3 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
