- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 44, Education Code, is
- amended by adding Section 44.0031 to read as follows: 6
- Sec. 44.0031. ELECTRONIC CHECKING ACCOUNT TRANSACTION 7
- REGISTER. (a) A school district shall maintain the transaction 8
- 9 register for the district's checking account in a searchable
- portable document format (PDF) in which the transaction register is 10
- readily available for purposes of Subsections (d) and (e). Except 11
- as provided by Subsection (b) or (c), the electronic checking 12
- account transaction register must include for each check written 13
- 14 from a district checking account:
- 15 (1) the transaction amount; and
- 16 (2) the name of the payee.
- (a-1) Beginning September 1, 2013, a school district's 17
- electronic checking account transaction register must contain the 18
- information required by Subsection (a) for each check dated on or 19
- after August 1, 2013. This subsection expires September 1, 2014. 20
- 21 (b) A school district may not include in the district's
- electronic checking account transaction register a check issued to 22
- 23 a district employee in payment of:
- 24 (1) salary, wages, or an employment stipend; or

- 1 (2) a workers' compensation income benefit, medical
- 2 benefit, death benefit, or burial benefit that is issued by a school
- 3 district operating as a self-insurer under Chapter 504, Labor Code.
- 4 (c) This section does not apply to a checking account
- 5 maintained by a school district or school campus solely for a
- 6 student activity fund.
- 7 (d) A school district shall prominently post at all times on
- 8 the home page of the district's Internet website a direct link to
- 9 the web page on the district's website that contains the district's
- 10 electronic checking account transaction register for viewing and
- 11 downloading by interested persons.
- 12 (e) A school district shall share data from the electronic
- 13 checking account transaction register with any interested person
- 14 who requests the data under Chapter 552, Government Code.
- 15 <u>(f) A school district shall:</u>
- 16 (1) update the electronic checking account
- 17 transaction register not later than the 90th day after the closing
- 18 date of the most recent monthly statement for the checking account;
- 19 and
- 20 (2) maintain each transaction or listing in the
- 21 <u>electronic checking account transaction register on the district's</u>
- 22 <u>Internet website until the second anniversary of the date of the</u>
- 23 transaction or listing.
- 24 (g) A school district with a student enrollment of fewer
- 25 than 500 students in kindergarten through grade 12 is not required
- 26 to comply with this section.
- 27 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
