4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 39.026, Education Code, is amended to

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7 Sec. 39.026. LOCAL OPTION. (a) Notwithstanding any other

8 provision of this title, in place of [In addition to] the assessment

instruments adopted by the agency and administered by the State

10 Board of Education, a school district board of trustees may adopt

11 and provide for administration by district employees of

12 [administer] criterion-referenced or norm-referenced assessment

13 instruments $[\frac{1}{\tau} \text{ or both}_{\tau}]$ at any grade level for which administration

of assessment instruments is required under Section 39.023. An [A

15 norm-referenced] assessment instrument adopted and administered

16 under this <u>subsection</u> [<u>section</u>] must be economical[, nationally

17 $\frac{\text{recognized}_{7}}{\text{and approved by the agency}}$ [state-approved]. The

18 commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary for the administration

19 of this subsection, including rules for using the assessment

20 <u>instruments</u> adopted and administered under this subsection for

21 purposes of this code in place of the assessment instruments

22 otherwise required under this subchapter.

23 (b) In addition to assessment instruments adopted and

24 administered under Subsection (a), a school district board of

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- 1 trustees may adopt and provide for administration of
- 2 criterion-referenced or norm-referenced assessment instruments at
- 3 any grade level. An assessment instrument adopted under this
- 4 subsection must be economical and approved by the agency.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2013-2014
- 6 school year.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
