5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 11.18, Tax Code, is amended by amending
7	Subsection (p) and adding Subsection (p-1) to read as follows:
8	(p) The exemption authorized by Subsection (d)(23) applies
9	only to property [improvements] that:
10	(1) <u>is</u> [ <del>are</del> ] owned by a charitable organization that
11	has been in existence for at least $\underline{12}$ [ $\underline{10}$ ] years;
12	(2) <u>is</u> [ <del>are</del> ] used to provide housing and related
13	services to individuals described by that subsection; and
14	(3) <u>is</u> [ <del>are</del> ] located on <u>or consists of</u> a single campus
15	<u>in</u> [ <del>owned by</del> ] a municipality with a population of more than 750,000
16	and less than 850,000 or within the extraterritorial jurisdiction
17	of such a municipality.
18	(p-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (a)(1), the exemption
19	authorized by Subsection (d)(23) applies to real property
20	regardless of whether the real property is considered to constitute
21	a building within the meaning of this section.
22	SECTION 2. This Act applies only to an ad valorem tax year
23	that begins on or after the effective date of this Act.
24	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2014.

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
