## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 551.104(b), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) A person may not operate a bicycle at nighttime unless
- 8 the <u>person or</u> bicycle is equipped with:
- 9 (1) a lamp [on the front of the bicycle] that emits a
- 10 flashing or steady white light visible from a distance of at least
- 11 500 feet in front of the bicycle; and
- 12 (2) [on the rear of the bicycle:
- 13 [(A) a red reflector that is:
- 14 [(i) of a type approved by the department;
- 15 and
- 16 [(ii) visible when directly in front of
- 17 lawful upper beams of motor vehicle headlamps from all distances
- 18 from 50 to 300 feet to the rear of the bicycle; or
- 19  $\left[\frac{\text{(B)}}{\text{)}}\right]$  a lamp that emits a <u>flashing or steady</u> red
- 20 light visible from a distance of 500 feet to the rear of the
- 21 bicycle.
- 22 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 23 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.

- 1 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 2 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 3 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
