(a) Not 8 9 later than the 30th day following the end of each calendar quarter, the State Office of Administrative Hearings shall submit a report 10 to the legislature indicating for each county the total number of 11 administrative hearings decided under this chapter during the 12 previous calendar quarter and, of those hearings: 13 14 (1) the percentage in which the administrative law judge decided in favor of the person who requested the hearing; and 15 16 (2) the percentage in which the administrative law judge decided in favor of the department. 17 18 (b) Not later than the 30th day following the end of each calendar quarter, the department shall submit a report to the 19 legislature indicating for each county the total number of appeals 20 from administrative hearings held under this chapter that were 21 decided during the previous calendar quarter and, of those appeals: 22 23 (1) the percentage in which the court decided in favor 24 of the person whose license was suspended; and

3 SECTION 2. The State Office of Administrative Hearings and
4 the Department of Public Safety shall submit the initial reports
5 required by Section 524.045, Transportation Code, as added by this
6 Act, not later than January 30, 2014, based on data from the
7 previous calendar quarter.
