4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 2155, Occupations Code, is amended by
6	adding Subchapter C to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER C. FIREARMS POLICY NOTICE
8	Sec. 2155.101. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "hotel" has
9	the meaning assigned by Section 156.001, Tax Code.
10	Sec. 2155.102. APPLICABILITY OF SUBCHAPTER. This subchapter
11	applies only to a hotel that has a policy prohibiting or restricting
12	the possession, storage, or transportation of firearms by hotel
13	guests.
14	Sec. 2155.103. NOTICE REGARDING FIREARMS POLICY. (a) A
15	hotel shall post on the hotel's Internet reservation website the
16	hotel's policy regarding the possession, storage, and
17	transportation of firearms. The hotel shall require the consumer
18	to acknowledge that the consumer has read the hotel's firearms
19	policy before the consumer finalizes the reservation with the
20	<pre>hotel.</pre>
21	(b) A hotel shall include information on how a consumer may
22	review the hotel's policy regarding the possession, storage, and
23	transportation of firearms if the hotel provides a written
24	confirmation or other terms and conditions to the consumer after

- 1 accepting the consumer's hotel reservation by telephone.
- 2 Sec. 2155.104. COURT WARNING; CIVIL PENALTY. (a) A court
- 3 may issue a warning to a hotel for a first violation of this
- 4 subchapter. After receiving a warning for the first violation, the
- 5 hotel is liable to the state for a civil penalty of \$200 for each
- 6 subsequent violation.
- 7 (b) The attorney general or an appropriate prosecuting
- 8 attorney may file suit for the issuance of a warning or the
- 9 collection of a civil penalty under this section.
- 10 (c) A civil penalty collected under this section shall be
- 11 sent to the comptroller for deposit in the general revenue fund.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
