1-14 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-15 AN ACT

1-16 relating to the authority to propose the creation of a fire control,
1-17 prevention, and emergency medical services district.
1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-19 SECTION 1. Section 344.051, Local Government Code, is
1-20 amended by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
1-21 (a-1) The governing body of a municipality may propose the
1-22 creation of a fire control, prevention, and emergency medical
1-23 services district under this chapter if the municipality:
1-24 (1) has a population of 5,000 or more and less than
1-25 25,000; and
1-26 (2) is located in a county with a population of 750,000
1-27 or more:
1-28 (A) in which all or part of a municipality with a
1-29 population of one million or more is located; and
1-30 (B) that is adjacent to a county with a
1-31 population of two million or more.
1-32 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
