## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to medical assistance for individuals residing in certain
- 3 institutions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 32.025, Human Resources Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subsections (g) and (h) to read as follows:
- 7 (g) The department shall accept an application for medical
- 8 assistance from a person residing in a nursing home who is applying
- 9 for that assistance under 42 U.S.C. Section 1396a(a)(10)(A)(ii)(V)
- 10 regardless of whether the person has resided in the nursing home for
- 11 the period required for eligibility by that section.
- 12 (h) The department may not determine the eligibility for
- 13 medical assistance of a person whose application is accepted under
- 14 Subsection (g) until the period required for eligibility by 42
- 15 U.S.C. Section 1396a(a)(10)(A)(ii)(V) has elapsed.
- 16 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 17 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 18 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 19 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 20 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 21 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
