- 17 into between the parties and approved by the court, except that the

- 1 (b) This subchapter <u>applies</u> [does not apply] to contractual
- 2 alimony or spousal maintenance, <u>including an agreement for the</u>
- 3 payment of maintenance under the terms of this chapter voluntarily
- 4 entered into between the parties and approved by the court, subject
- 5 to the limits on the court's authority to enforce the agreement
- 6 under Section 8.059(a) [regardless of whether the alimony or
- 7 maintenance is taxable, unless:
- 8 [(1) the contract specifically permits income
- 9 withholding; or
- 10 [(2) the alimony or maintenance payments are not
- 11 timely made under the terms of the contract].
- 12 SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act to Chapter 8,
- 13 Family Code, apply to an order for maintenance or a maintenance
- 14 agreement under Subchapter B, Chapter 8, Family Code, regardless of
- 15 whether the order was rendered or the agreement was approved
- 16 before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
