H.B. No. 392

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to newborn screening for congenital heart defects.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. The heading to Chapter 33, Health and Safety
- 5 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 CHAPTER 33. PHENYLKETONURIA, OTHER HERITABLE DISEASES,
- 7 HYPOTHYROIDISM, CONGENITAL HEART DEFECTS, AND CERTAIN OTHER
- 8 DISORDERS
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 33.001, Health and Safety Code, is
- 10 amended by amending Subdivision (1) and adding Subdivision (1-a) to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 (1) "Congenital heart defect" means an abnormality in
- 13 the structure and function of the heart that exists at birth.
- 14 (1-a) "Heritable disease" means an inherited disease
- 15 that may result in mental or physical retardation or death.
- SECTION 3. Sections 33.002(a) and (c), Health and Safety
- 17 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 18 (a) The department shall carry out a program to combat
- 19 morbidity, including mental retardation, and mortality in persons
- 20 who have phenylketonuria, other heritable diseases, [or]
- 21 hypothyroidism, or congenital heart defects.
- 22 (c) The department shall establish and maintain a
- 23 laboratory to:
- 24 (1) conduct experiments, projects, and other

- 1 activities necessary to develop screening or diagnostic tests for
- 2 the early detection of phenylketonuria, other heritable diseases,
- 3 [and] hypothyroidism, and congenital heart defects;
- 4 (2) develop ways and means or discover methods to be
- 5 used to prevent or treat phenylketonuria, other heritable diseases,
- 6 [and] hypothyroidism, and congenital heart defects; and
- 7 (3) serve other purposes considered necessary by the
- 8 department to carry out the program.
- 9 SECTION 4. Sections 33.011(a) and (c), Health and Safety
- 10 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 11 (a) The physician attending a newborn child or the person
- 12 attending the delivery of a newborn child that is not attended by a
- 13 physician shall subject the child to:
- 14 (1) screening tests approved by the department for
- 15 phenylketonuria, other heritable diseases, hypothyroidism, and
- 16 other disorders for which screening is required by the department $\underline{:}$
- 17 and
- 18 (2) a pulse oximetry screening test for congenital
- 19 heart defects.
- 20 (c) Except for the pulse oximetry screening test required by
- 21 Subsection (a)(2), the [The] screening tests required by this
- 22 section must be performed by the laboratory established by the
- 23 department or by a laboratory approved by the department under
- 24 Section 33.016.
- 25 SECTION 5. Section 33.014(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 26 amended to read as follows:
- 27 (a) If, because of an analysis of a specimen submitted under

- 1 Section 33.011, the department reasonably suspects that a newborn
- 2 child may have phenylketonuria, another heritable disease,
- 3 hypothyroidism, or another disorder for which the screening tests
- 4 are required, the department shall notify the person who submits
- 5 the specimen that the results are abnormal and provide the test
- 6 results to that person. The department may notify one or more of
- 7 the following that the results of the analysis or of a screening
- 8 test reported to the department under Section 33.015 are abnormal
- 9 and recommend further testing when necessary:
- 10 (1) the physician attending the newborn child or the
- 11 physician's designee;
- 12 (2) the person attending the delivery of the newborn
- 13 child that was not attended by a physician;
- 14 (3) the parents of the newborn child;
- 15 (4) the health authority of the jurisdiction in which
- 16 the newborn child was born or in which the child resides, if known;
- 17 or
- 18 (5) physicians who are cooperating pediatric
- 19 specialists for the program.
- SECTION 6. Section 33.031(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 21 amended to read as follows:
- 22 (a) All newborn children and other individuals under 21
- 23 years of age who have been screened, have been found to be
- 24 presumptively positive through the newborn screening program for
- 25 phenylketonuria, other heritable diseases, hypothyroidism,
- 26 <u>congenital heart defects</u>, or another disorder for which the
- 27 screening tests are required, and may be financially eligible may

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- 1 be referred to the department's services program for children with
- 2 special health care needs.
- 3 SECTION 7. Section 33.032(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 (a) Within the limits of funds available for this purpose
- 6 and in cooperation with the individual's physician, the department
- 7 may provide services directly or through approved providers to
- 8 individuals of any age who meet the eligibility criteria specified
- 9 by board rules on the confirmation of a positive test for
- 10 phenylketonuria, other heritable diseases, hypothyroidism,
- 11 congenital heart defects, or another disorder for which the
- 12 screening tests are required.
- 13 SECTION 8. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 14 of this Act, the Department of State Health Services shall
- 15 implement the changes in law made by this Act to the newborn
- 16 screening program under Chapter 33, Health and Safety Code.
- 17 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
