- 7 Sec. 33.030. INCLUSION OF INCOME AND EXPENSES OF INELIGIBLE
- HOUSEHOLD MEMBERS IN DETERMINING SNAP ELIGIBILITY. To the extent 8
- 9 allowed by federal law, in determining the eligibility for
- supplemental nutrition assistance benefits of a household that 10
- 11 includes a person who is ineligible for those benefits, the
- 12 department shall include in the household income all of the income
- and deductible expenses of the ineligible household member. 13
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 33.030, Human Resources Code, as added
- by this Act, applies to an initial determination or recertification 15
- 16 of eligibility for the supplemental nutrition assistance program
- under Chapter 33, Human Resources Code, that is made on or after the 17
- effective date of this Act. 18

- SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act 19
- a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a 20
- 21 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or 22
- 23 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- waiver or authorization is granted. 24
