 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to charitable contributions by state employees to assist
 1-18 domestic victims of human trafficking.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 531.383, Government Code, is amended by
 1-21 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:

1-22 (f) For purposes of Subchapter I, Chapter 659:

1-23 (1) the commission, for the sole purpose of
 1-24 administering the grant program under this section, is considered
 1-25 an eligible charitable organization entitled to participate in the
 1-26 state employee charitable campaign; and

1-27 (2) a state employee is entitled to authorize a
 1-28 deduction for contributions to the commission for the purposes of
 1-29 administering the grant program under this section as a charitable
 1-30 contribution under Section 659.132, and the commission may use the
 1-31 contributions as provided by Subsection (a).

1-32 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-33 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-34 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-35 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-36 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
