- 3 SECTION 2. (a) Sections 134.001(1), 134.005, and 134.007,
- 4 Education Code, are repealed.
- 5 (b) Subchapter O, Chapter 403, Government Code, is
- 6 repealed.
- 7 SECTION 3. A person receiving a scholarship or other
- 8 financial assistance under Chapter 134, Education Code, or
- 9 Subchapter O, Chapter 403, Government Code, before the effective
- 10 date of this Act for the 2013-2014 academic year may continue to
- 11 receive a scholarship or other financial assistance under that law
- 12 as applicable to the person immediately before the effective date,
- 13 until the person is no longer eligible for the scholarship or other
- 14 assistance under Chapter 134, Education Code, or Subchapter O,
- 15 Chapter 403, Government Code, as the applicable law exists on
