Section 25.087(b), Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (b) A school district shall excuse a student from attending school for: 8 (1) the following purposes, including travel for those 9 10 purposes: 11 (A) observing religious holy days; 12 (B) attending a required court appearance; 13 appearing at a governmental office to (C) 14 complete paperwork required in connection with the student's application for United States citizenship; 15 taking part in a United States naturalization 16 (D) 17 oath ceremony; or 18 (E) serving as an election clerk; or a temporary absence resulting from an appointment 19 (2) with health care professionals for the student or the student's 20 child if the [that] student commences classes or returns to school 21 on the same day of the appointment. 22 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2013-2014 23 24 school year.

1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
