1-19 relating to excused absences from public school for certain 1-20 students.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 25.087(b), Education Code, is amended to read as follows:

- A school district shall excuse a student from attending (b) school for:
- (1)the following purposes, including travel for those purposes:
 - observing religious holy days; (A)
 - (B) attending a required court appearance;
- (C) appearing at a governmental office complete paperwork required in connection with the student's application for United States citizenship;
- taking part in a United States naturalization (D) oath ceremony; or
 - (E) serving as an election clerk; or
- (2) a temporary absence resulting from an appointment with health care professionals for the student or the student's child if the [that] student commences classes or returns to school on the same day of the appointment. SECTION 2. This Act applie

This Act applies beginning with the 2013-2014 school year.

This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-42 SECTION 3. a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-43 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-44 1-45 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-46 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
