 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to eligibility requirements for a residential fire alarm  
 1-20 training school instructor.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 6002.158(c), Insurance Code, is amended  
 1-23 to read as follows:

1-24 (c) Training school instructors must be approved by the  
 1-25 state fire marshal. To be eligible for approval, an instructor  
 1-26 must:

1-27 (1) hold a fire alarm planning superintendent license,  
 1-28 a residential fire alarm superintendent license, or a fire alarm  
 1-29 technician license; and

1-30 (2) have at least three years of experience in fire  
 1-31 alarm installation, service, or monitoring.

1-32 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only  
 1-33 to an application for approval or renewal of approval of a training  
 1-34 school instructor submitted to the state fire marshal on or after  
 1-35 the effective date of this Act. An application submitted before the  
 1-36 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect  
 1-37 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is  
 1-38 continued in effect for that purpose.

1-39 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
