A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the creation of a navigator program as described by the
3	Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle G, Title 8, Insurance Code, is amended
6	by adding Chapter 1509 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 1509. NAVIGATOR PROGRAM
8	Sec. 1509.001. NAVIGATOR PROGRAM. (a) The department
9	shall:
10	(1) establish a navigator program as described by
11	Section 1311(i), Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (42
12	<pre>U.S.C. Section 18031(i));</pre>
13	(2) select entities qualified to serve as navigators
14	in accordance with Section 1311(i), Patient Protection and
15	Affordable Care Act (42 U.S.C. Section 18031(i)), and standards
16	developed by the secretary of the United States Department of
17	Health and Human Services;
18	(3) adopt rules governing the certification of a
19	navigator;
20	(4) certify navigators as able to carry out the duties
21	required by Section 1311(i)(3), Patient Protection and Affordable
22	<pre>Care Act (42 U.S.C. Section 18031(i)(3)); and</pre>

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(b) At a minimum, training under this section must:

(5) provide training to navigators.

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- 1 (1) enable a navigator to provide individuals and
- 2 enrollees with complete and accurate information about coverages
- 3 available through a health care exchange formed in compliance with
- 4 Section 1311, Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (42 U.S.C.
- 5 Section 18031); and
- 6 (2) educate navigators regarding how, and under what
- 7 circumstances, to refer an individual or enrollee to an agent
- 8 licensed under Section 4054.051.
- 9 (c) The department may charge a reasonable fee for training
- 10 services provided under this section, except that the department
- 11 may not charge a fee to a navigator that is a nonprofit, tax-exempt
- 12 organization listed in Section 501(c) or (d) of the Internal
- 13 Revenue Code of 1986, including a faith-based organization.
- 14 (d) A navigator may not:
- (1) sell, solicit the sale or purchase of, or
- 16 negotiate concerning the sale of health benefit plan coverage; or
- 17 (2) receive a commission from a health benefit plan
- 18 issuer or other insurer.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
