- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 62, Election Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Section 62.0016 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 62.0016. VOTER REGISTRARS MUST BE PRESENT. Two voter
- 8 registrars must be present at each polling place while the polls are
- 9 open.

- 10 SECTION 2. Chapter 63, Election Code, is amended by adding
- 11 Section 63.010 to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 63.010. REGISTRATION AT POLLING PLACE; VOTING
- 13 PROCEDURES. (a) Other applicable provisions of this code apply to
- 14 the conduct of voting and to the registration of voters under this
- 15 section to the extent those provisions do not conflict with this
- 16 section.
- 17 (b) A person who would be eligible to vote in an election
- 18 under Section 11.001, but for the requirement to be a registered
- 19 voter, shall be accepted for voting in the precinct of the person's
- 20 residence if, on the day the person offers to vote, the person:
- 21 (1) submits a voter registration application that
- 22 complies with Section 13.002 to a voter registrar at the polling
- 23 place; and
- 24 (2) presents as proof of identification:

- 1 (A) a Texas driver's license, including a
- 2 temporary license or instruction permit, or personal
- 3 identification card issued to the person by the Department of
- 4 Public Safety that states the person's current address on the day
- 5 the person seeks to vote; or
- 6 (B) a utility bill addressed to the person dated
- 7 not earlier than the 30th day before the date the person seeks to
- 8 vote, and:
- 9 (i) a Texas driver's license, including a
- 10 temporary license or instruction permit, or personal
- 11 identification card issued to the person by the Department of
- 12 Public Safety, regardless of whether the address stated on the
- 13 license or card is current on the day the person seeks to vote;
- 14 (ii) a United States passport issued to the
- 15 person; or
- (iii) a United States military
- 17 identification card that contains the person's photograph.
- 18 (c) Persons voting under this section shall be processed
- 19 separately at the polling place from persons who are voting under
- 20 regular procedures.
- 21 (d) The secretary of state shall adopt rules to ensure the
- 22 accountability of election officers and to fairly implement this
- 23 section.
- SECTION 3. Section 85.031(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 25 read as follows:
- 26 (a) For each person entitled to vote an early voting ballot
- 27 by personal appearance or entitled to register at a polling place,

- 1 the early voting clerk shall follow the procedure for accepting or
- 2 <u>registering</u> a regular voter on election day, with the modifications
- 3 necessary for the conduct of early voting.
- 4 SECTION 4. The secretary of state shall adopt rules as
- 5 required by Section 63.010, Election Code, as added by this Act, not
- 6 later than February 1, 2014.
- 7 SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 8 an election for which early voting by personal appearance begins on
- 9 or after February 1, 2014.
- 10 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
