18	(b) The procedure must include a requirement that the county

- 1 than the 14th day before the date the award of the sale or lease is

- 3 (B) on the county's official website
- 4 continuously for the 14 days immediately before the date the award
- 5 of the sale or lease is made;
- 6 (2) include a description of the advertising space,
- 7 including its location and a description of the part of any real or
- 8 personal property that the advertising space occupies; and
- 9 (3) include a description of the procedure by which
- 10 bids or proposals for the sale or lease may be submitted.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
