- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 661, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 661.923 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 661.923. LEAVE TO ATTEND EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES. (a)
- 8 In this section:
- 9 <u>(1) "Educational activity" means a school-sponsored</u>
- 10 activity, including a parent-teacher conference, tutoring, a
- 11 volunteer program, a field trip, a classroom program, a school
- 12 committee meeting, an academic competition, and an athletic, music,
- 13 <u>or theater program.</u>
- 14 (2) "Parent" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 15 61.101, Family Code.
- 16 (b) This section applies to an employee who is a parent of a
- 17 child who is a student attending a grade from prekindergarten
- 18 through 12th grade.
- 19 (c) In addition to leave under Section 661.206, a state
- 20 employee is entitled to a leave of absence not to exceed eight hours
- 21 each fiscal year without a deduction in salary for the purpose of
- 22 attending educational activities of the employee's child.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
