5	SECTION 1. Chapter 370, Local Government Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 370.006 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 370.006. ASSISTANCE IN MAN-MADE OR NATURAL DISASTER.
8	(a) The governing body of a municipality, the chief of the fire
9	department, or an emergency management director or coordinator
10	designated for the municipality under Section 418.1015, Government
11	Code, may request or accept any care, assistance, or advice
12	described by Section 79.003(a), Civil Practice and Remedies Code,
13	including the loan or operation of construction equipment or other
14	heavy equipment by the owner or operator of the equipment, as
15	applicable, or the donation of resources to the extent the
16	governing body, chief, or emergency management director or
17	coordinator believes necessary to address a man-made or natural
18	<u>disaster.</u>
19	(b) The commissioners court of a county, the county judge,
20	the county fire marshal, an incorporated volunteer fire department
21	under contract with a county under Section 352.001, a volunteer
22	fire department described by Section 352.005, as applicable, or an
23	emergency management director or coordinator designated for the
24	county under Section 418.1015, Government Code, may request or

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accept any care, assistance, or advice described by Section 1 79.003(a), Civil Practice and Remedies Code, including the loan or 2 3 operation of construction equipment or other heavy equipment by the owner or operator of the equipment, as applicable, or the donation 4 of resources to the extent the commissioners court, county judge, 5 county fire marshal, volunteer fire department, or emergency 6 management director or coordinator believes necessary to address a 7 man-made or natur<u>al disaster.</u> 8 9 (c) A person as defined by Section 79.001, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, who provides care, assistance, or advice to a 10 municipality or county in the manner described by this section is 11 12 immune from civil liability as provided by Section 79.003, Civil Practice and Remedies Code. 13 14 (d) Subsection (a) or (b) does not authorize the acceptance 15 of care, assistance, or advice in violation of any other law or contractual agreement that prohibits the acceptance of that care, 16 17 assistance, or advice. SECTION 2. Section 370.006, Local Government Code, as added 18 19 by this Act, is intended only to clarify existing law with respect 20 to: 21 (1) the power of certain local officials to request or accept certain assistance in certain situations; and 22 23 (2) applicability of Section 79.003, Civil the 24 Practice and Remedies Code, to certain persons providing certain assistance in certain situations. 25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 27

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provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
