## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the restriction of access to the records and files of a
- 3 child charged with or convicted of certain fine-only misdemeanor
- 4 offenses.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article 44.2811, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 Art. 44.2811. RECORDS RELATING TO CHILDREN CONVICTED OF
- 9 CERTAIN FINE-ONLY MISDEMEANORS. [All records and files and
- 10 information stored by electronic means or otherwise, from which a
- 11 record or file could be generated, relating to a child who is
- 12 convicted of and has satisfied the judgment for a fine-only
- 13 misdemeanor offense other than a traffic offense are confidential
- 14 and may not be disclosed to the public except as provided under
- 15 Article 45.0217(b).] All records and files and information stored
- 16 by electronic means or otherwise, from which a record or file could
- 17 be generated, relating to a child whose conviction for a fine-only
- 18 misdemeanor other than a traffic offense is  $\underline{appealed}$  [ $\underline{affirmed}$ ] are
- 19 confidential [upon satisfaction of the judgment] and may not be
- 20 disclosed to the public except as provided under Article
- 21 45.0217(b).
- 22 SECTION 2. The heading to Article 45.0217, Code of Criminal
- 23 Procedure, is amended to read as follows:
- 24 Art. 45.0217. CONFIDENTIAL RECORDS RELATED TO CHARGES

- 1 AGAINST OR THE CONVICTION OF A CHILD.
- 2 SECTION 3. Article 45.0217(a), Code of Criminal Procedure,
- 3 is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (a) Except as provided by Article 15.27 and Subsection (b),
- 5 all records and files, including those held by law enforcement, and
- 6 information stored by electronic means or otherwise, from which a
- 7 record or file could be generated, relating to a child who is
- 8 charged with or convicted of [and has satisfied the judgment for] a
- 9 fine-only misdemeanor offense other than a traffic offense are
- 10 confidential and may not be disclosed to the public.
- 11 SECTION 4. Section 58.00711, Family Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 58.00711. RECORDS RELATING TO CHILDREN CHARGED WITH OR
- 14 CONVICTED OF FINE-ONLY MISDEMEANORS. Except as provided by Article
- 15 45.0217(b), Code of Criminal Procedure, all records and files and
- 16 information stored by electronic means or otherwise, from which a
- 17 record or file could be generated, relating to a child who is
- 18 charged with or convicted of [and has satisfied the judgment for] a
- 19 fine-only misdemeanor offense other than a traffic offense are
- 20 confidential and may not be disclosed to the public.
- SECTION 5. Articles 44.2811 and 45.0217, Code of Criminal
- 22 Procedure, and Section 58.00711, Family Code, as amended by this
- 23 Act, apply to an offense committed before, on, or after the
- 24 effective date of this Act.
- 25 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
