H.B. No. 515

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT  
2 relating to the remittance of certain taxes and fees and the  
3 allocation of certain state money.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. The following provisions of the Alcoholic  
6 Beverage Code are repealed:

- 7 (1) Sections 34.04(c), (d), and (e);
- 8 (2) Sections 48.04(c), (d), and (e);
- 9 (3) Sections 201.07(b), (c), and (d);
- 10 (4) Sections 201.43(c), (d), and (e); and
- 11 (5) Sections 203.03(c), (d), and (e).

12 SECTION 2. Section 466.355(c), Government Code, is  
13 repealed.

14 SECTION 3. The following provisions of the Tax Code are  
15 repealed:

- 16 (1) Sections 151.401(c), (d), and (e);
- 17 (2) Section 151.402(b);
- 18 (3) Sections 162.113(a-1), (a-2), (a-3), and (a-4);
- 19 (4) Sections 162.214(a-1), (a-2), (a-3), and (a-4);
- 20 (5) Section 162.503(b);
- 21 (6) Section 162.504(b); and
- 22 (7) Sections 183.023(c), (d), and (e).

23 SECTION 4. (a) This Act takes effect immediately if it  
24 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each

1 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.  
2 Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this section, if this Act  
3 does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act  
4 has no effect.

5 (b) If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for  
6 immediate effect, Section 2 of this Act takes effect September 1,  
7 2013.
