## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to making a voluntary contribution to the donor registry
- 3 when registering a motor vehicle or applying for a driver's license
- 4 or personal identification certificate.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 502.405(b), Transportation Code, as
- 7 redesignated from Section 502.1745(b), Transportation Code, by
- 8 Chapter 1296 (H.B. 2357), Acts of the 82nd Legislature, Regular
- 9 Session, 2011, is reenacted to incorporate amendments to Section
- 10 502.1745(b), Transportation Code, made by Chapters 554 (H.B. 2904)
- 11 and 1296 (H.B. 2357), Acts of the 82nd Legislature, Regular
- 12 Session, 2011, and amended to read as follows:
- 13 (b) A person may elect to pay an additional fee of \$1 for the
- 14 registration or renewal of registration of a motor vehicle to pay
- 15 the costs of the Glenda Dawson Donate Life-Texas Registry
- 16 established under Chapter 692A, Health and Safety Code. The county
- 17 assessor-collector shall hold any additional fee paid under this
- 18 subsection in trust for the nonprofit organization administering
- 19 the Glenda Dawson Donate Life-Texas Registry under Chapter 692A,
- 20 Health and Safety Code. Not later than the 14th day of each month,
- 21 the county assessor-collector shall send the money collected under
- 22 this subsection to the organization. Before sending the money to
- 23 the organization, the county assessor-collector may deduct money
- 24 equal to the amount of reasonable expenses for administering this

- 1 subsection. Money received under this subsection by the
- 2 organization may be used only to manage the organization's
- 3 registry. The organization shall submit an annual report to the
- 4 legislature and the comptroller that includes the total dollar
- 5 amount of money received by the organization under this subsection.
- 6 [Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, all fees
- 7 collected under this subsection shall be remitted to the
- 8 comptroller, who shall maintain the identity of the source of the

- 10 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
- 11 is amended by adding Section 521.008 to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 521.008. VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION TO DONOR REGISTRY.
- 13 (a) When a person applies for an original or renewal driver's
- 14 license under this chapter, the person may contribute \$1 or more to
- 15 the nonprofit organization administering the Glenda Dawson Donate
- 16 <u>Life-Texas Registry under Chapter 692A</u>, Health and Safety Code.
- 17 (b) The department shall:
- 18 (1) include space on each application for a new or
- 19 renewal driver's license that allows a person applying for a new or
- 20 renewal driver's license to indicate the amount that the person is
- 21 voluntarily contributing to the organization; and
- 22 (2) provide an opportunity for the person to
- 23 contribute to the organization during the application process for a
- 24 new or renewal driver's license on the department's Internet
- 25 website.
- 26 (c) The department shall hold any contribution made under
- 27 this section in trust for the organization. Not later than the 14th

- 1 day of each month, the department shall send the money collected
- 2 under this section to the organization. Before sending the money to
- 3 the organization, the department may deduct money equal to the
- 4 amount of reasonable expenses for administering this section.
- 5 (d) Money received under this section by the organization
- 6 may be used only to manage the organization's registry.
- 7 <u>(e) The organization shall submit an annual report to the</u>
- 8 legislature and the comptroller that includes the total dollar
- 9 amount of contributions received by the organization under this
- 10 section.
- 11 SECTION 3. Section 521.422(c), Transportation Code, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- (c) A person may elect to pay [The department shall collect]
- 14 an additional fee of \$1 for the issuance or renewal of a personal
- 15 identification card, including a duplicate personal identification
- 16 card or a personal identification card issued or renewed over the
- 17 Internet or by other electronic means, to pay the costs of the
- 18 Glenda Dawson Donate Life-Texas Registry established under Chapter
- 19 692A, Health and Safety Code[, if the person applying for or
- 20 renewing a personal identification card opts to pay the additional
- 21 fee. The department shall remit fees collected under this
- 22 subsection to the comptroller, who shall maintain the identity of
- 23 the source of the fees. Subject to appropriation, the department
- 24 may retain three percent of the money collected under this
- 25 subsection to cover the costs in administering this subsection].
- 26 The department shall hold any additional fee paid under this
- 27 subsection in trust for the nonprofit organization administering

- 1 the Glenda Dawson Donate Life-Texas Registry under Chapter 692A,
- 2 Health and Safety Code. Not later than the 14th day of each month,
- 3 the department shall send the money collected under this subsection
- 4 to the organization. Before sending the money to the organization,
- 5 the department may deduct money equal to the amount of reasonable
- 6 expenses for administering this subsection. Money received by the
- 7 organization may be used only to manage the organization's
- 8 registry. The organization shall submit an annual report to the
- 9 legislature and the comptroller that includes the total dollar
- 10 amount of money received by the organization under this subsection.
- 11 SECTION 4. Section 521.008, Transportation Code, as added
- 12 by this Act, applies only to a driver's license issued or renewed on
- 13 or after January 1, 2014.
- 14 SECTION 5. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails
- 15 over another Act of the 83rd Legislature, Regular Session, 2013,
- 16 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted
- 17 codes.
- SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
