Subtitle C, Title 10, Insurance Code, is amended by adding Chapter 1954 to read as follows: 6 7 CHAPTER 1954. ASSIGNMENT AND DIRECT PAYMENT OF CERTAIN BENEFITS 8 UNDER AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE POLICY 9 Sec. 1954.001. APPLICABILITY OF CHAPTER. This chapter applies to an insurer writing automobile insurance in this state, 10 including an insurance company, corporation, reciprocal or 11 interinsurance exchange, mutual insurance company, association, 12 13 Lloyd's plan, or other insurer. 14 Sec. 1954.002. ASSIGNMENT OF BENEFITS OPTION REQUIRED. An automobile insurance policy claim form must provide an option for 15 16 the claimant to assign benefits to an emergency medical services provider who provides ambulance services or other services covered 17 under the policy in connection with an occurrence covered by the 18 policy. The automobile insurer may require a written attestation 19 of assignment of benefits. 20 21 Sec. 1954.003. DIRECT PAYMENT PROVISION AUTHORIZED. An automobile insurance policy may provide for payment of benefits 22 23 directly to an emergency medical services provider who provides ambulance services or other services covered under the policy in 24

1 <u>connection with an occurrence covered by the policy, even in the</u>
2 <u>absence of an assignment of benefits.</u>

3 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 4 an insurance policy delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on 5 or after January 1, 2014. An insurance policy delivered, issued for 6 delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2014, is governed by the law 7 in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and 8 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
