H.B. No. 525

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1
2 relating to the collection of data relating to military-connected
3 students through the Public Education Information Management
4 System (PEIMS).

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 25.006, Education Code, is amended by
7 adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:

8 (c) The agency shall collect data each year from school
9 districts and open-enrollment charter schools through the Public
10 Education Information Management System (PEIMS) relating to the
11 enrollment of military-connected students. The data relating to the
12 enrollment of military-connected students under this section:

13 (1) must include the number of active duty
14 military-connected students and the number of National Guard or
15 reserve military-connected students enrolled in the school
16 district or open-enrollment charter school on a date at the
17 beginning of the school year specified by the agency and a date at
18 the end of the school year specified by the agency; and

19 (2) may not be used for purposes of determining a
20 campus or district performance rating under Section 39.054.

21 (d) In this section, "military-connected student" means a
22 student enrolled in a school district or open-enrollment charter
23 school who is a dependent of a member of:

24 (1) the United States military serving in the Army,

- 1 Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, or Coast Guard on active duty;
- 2 (2) the Texas National Guard; or
- 3 (3) a reserve force of the United States military.

4 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2013-2014
5 school year.

6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
10 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
