A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the collection of data relating to military-connected students through the Public Education Information Management 3 System (PEIMS). 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Section 25.006, Education Code, is amended by adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows: 7 (c) The agency shall collect data each year from school 8 9 districts and open-enrollment charter schools through the Public Education Information Management System (PEIMS) relating to the 10 enrollment of military-connected students. The data relating to the 11 12 enrollment of military-connected students under this section: 13 (1) must include the number of active duty 14 military-connected students and the number of National Guard or reserve military-connected students enrolled in the school 15 district or open-enrollment charter school on a date at the 16 beginning of the school year specified by the agency and a date at 17 the end of the school year specified by the agency; and 18 (2) may not be used for purposes of determining a 19 campus or district performance rating under Section 39.054. 20 (d) In this section, "military-connected student" means a 21 student enrolled in a school district or open-enrollment charter 22 23 school who is a dependent of a member of: 24 (1) the United States military serving in the Army,

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1 Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, or Coast Guard on active duty;

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(2) the Texas National Guard; or(3) a reserve force of the United States military.

4 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2013-2014 5 school year.

6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
