- 5 SECTION 1. Section 38.03, Penal Code, is amended by

- 8 (d) An offense under this section is:
- 9 (1) a state jail felony if it is shown on the trial of
- 10 the offense that the defendant has been previously convicted of an
- 11 offense under this section; and
- 12 (2) a felony of the third degree if the <u>defendant used</u>
- 13 [actor uses] a deadly weapon to resist the arrest or search.
- (e) For purposes of Subsection (d)(1), a defendant has been
- 15 previously convicted under this section if the defendant was
- 16 adjudged guilty of the offense or entered a plea of guilty or nolo
- 17 contendere in return for a grant of deferred adjudication,
- 18 regardless of whether the sentence for the offense was ever imposed
- 19 or whether the sentence was probated and the defendant was
- 20 <u>subsequently discharged from community supervision.</u>
- 21 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 22 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 23 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 24 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,

- 1 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 2 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 3 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 4 before that date.
