2	relating to the waiver of sovereign immunity in certain employment
3	lawsuits by nurses.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 301.413, Occupations Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsections (g), (h), (i), (j), (k), and (l) to read as
7	follows:
8	(g) Subject to Subsection (h), a nurse employed by a
9	hospital operated by or on behalf of a state or local governmental
10	entity who alleges a violation of Subsection (b) may sue the state
11	or local governmental entity for relief under this section, and the
12	sovereign immunity of the state or local governmental entity from
13	suit and from liability is waived for the limited purpose of
14	allowing the nurse to maintain a lawsuit in state court to obtain
15	that relief. Relief under this section is in addition to any other
16	remedies a nurse may have under state or federal law as a public
17	employee. In this subsection:
18	(1) "Local governmental entity," "public employee,"
19	and "state governmental entity" have the meanings assigned by
20	Section 554.001, Government Code.
21	(2) "Hospital" has the meaning assigned by Section
22	241.003, Health and Safety Code, and includes a mental hospital
23	licensed under Chapter 577, Health and Safety Code.
24	(h) Relief may be granted in a lawsuit brought under

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1	Subsection (g) for an alleged violation of Subsection (b)(1) based
2	on a report made by a nurse under Section 301.4025(b) only if the
3	nurse:
4	(1) made the report:
5	(A) in writing, which may be provided
6	electronically; or
7	(B) verbally, if authorized by the nurse's
8	employer or another entity at which the nurse is authorized to
9	<pre>practice;</pre>
10	(2) made the report to:
11	(A) the nurse's supervisor;
12	(B) a committee authorized under state or federal
13	law to receive reports under Section 301.4025(b); or
14	(C) an individual or committee authorized by the
15	nurse's employer or another entity at which the nurse is authorized
16	to practice; and
17	(3) made the report not later than:
18	(A) the fifth day after the date the nurse became
19	aware of the situation if the situation involves a single incident;
20	or
21	(B) the fifth day after the date the nurse became
22	aware of the most recent occurrence of the situation if the
23	situation involves multiple incidents or a pattern of behavior.
24	(i) For purposes of Subsection (h), "supervisor" means an
25	individual who has authority over the responsibilities of the nurse
26	making the report or an individual who is in the nurse's chain of
27	command.

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1	(j) The following provisions of Chapter 554, Government
2	Code, apply to a lawsuit under Subsection (g):
3	(1) the type of relief and the amount of damages
4	available to a public employee under Section 554.003;
5	(2) the time during which a public employee must seek
6	relief under Section 554.005; and
7	(3) the requirement that a public employee use the
8	grievance or appeal procedures of the state or local governmental
9	entity before suing for relief under Section 554.006.
10	(k) A lawsuit under Subsection (g) against a state
11	governmental entity shall be brought in a district court in Travis
12	County or a county in which all or part of the acts or omissions
13	giving rise to the cause of action occurred.
14	(l) A lawsuit under Subsection (g) against a local
15	governmental entity shall be brought in a district court in a county
16	in which all or part of the entity is located.
17	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
18	301.413, Occupations Code, applies to an action commenced on or
19	after the effective date of this Act. An action commenced before
20	the effective date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed
21	immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
22	continued in effect for that purpose.
23	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
