- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 453.151, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 5 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 6 (c) Information regarding the home address or personal
- 7 telephone number of a person licensed under this chapter or a person
- 8 who is an owner or manager of a physical therapy facility registered
- 9 under this chapter is confidential and not subject to disclosure
- 10 under Chapter 552, Government Code. A person licensed under this
- 11 chapter or a person who is an owner or manager of a physical therapy
- 12 facility registered under this chapter must provide the board with
- 13 <u>a business address or address of record that will be subject to</u>
- 14 disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 453.212, Occupations Code, is amended to
- 16 read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 453.212. DISPLAY OF LICENSE [AND RENEWAL CERTIFICATE].
- 18 A license holder under this chapter shall display the license
- 19 holder's license [and renewal certificate] in a conspicuous place
- 20 in the principal office in which the license holder practices
- 21 physical therapy.
- SECTION 3. Sections 453.252(b), (c), and (d), Occupations
- 23 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- (b) A person whose license has been expired for 90 days or

- 1 less may renew the license by paying to the executive council the
- 2 renewal fee and a <u>late</u> fee <u>set by the executive council in an amount</u>
- 3 that does not exceed one-half [that is equal to half] of the amount
- 4 charged for examination for the license. If a person's license has
- 5 been expired for more than 90 days but less than one year, the
- 6 person may renew the license by paying to the executive council all
- 7 unpaid renewal fees and a <u>late</u> fee <u>set by the executive council in</u>
- 8 an amount that does not exceed [that is equal to] the amount charged
- 9 for examination for the license.
- 10 (c) A person whose license has been expired for one year or
- 11 longer must comply with the board's requirements and procedures to
- 12 <u>reinstate the license and pay a reinstatement fee in the amount set</u>
- 13 by the executive council [may not renew the license]. If the person
- 14 is unable to comply with the board's requirements to reinstate the
- 15 <u>license</u>, the [The] person may obtain a new license by submitting to
- 16 reexamination and complying with the requirements and procedures
- 17 for obtaining an original license.
- 18 (d) At least 30 days before the expiration of a person's
- 19 license, the executive council shall provide the person with [send
- 20 written] notice of the impending license expiration [to the person
- 21 at the person's last known address according to the records of the
- 22 executive council].
- 23 SECTION 4. Section 453.253, Occupations Code, is amended to
- 24 read as follows:
- Sec. 453.253. RENEWAL OF EXPIRED LICENSE BY OUT-OF-STATE
- 26 PRACTITIONER. (a) The board may renew without reexamination the
- 27 expired license of a person who was licensed to practice as a

- 1 physical therapist or physical therapist assistant in this state,
- 2 moved to another state, [and] is currently licensed and in good
- 3 <u>standing</u> [has been in practice] in the other state, and meets the
- 4 board's requirements for renewal [for the two years preceding
- 5 application].
- 6 (b) The person must pay to the executive council a <u>renewal</u>
- 7 fee set by the executive council in an amount that does not exceed
- 8 [that is equal to] the examination fee for the license.
- 9 SECTION 5. (a) Not later than December 1, 2013, the Texas
- 10 Board of Physical Therapy Examiners and the Executive Council of
- 11 Physical Therapy and Occupational Therapy Examiners shall adopt
- 12 rules and fees necessary to implement Sections 453.252 and 453.253,
- 13 Occupations Code, as amended by this Act.
- 14 (b) Sections 453.252 and 453.253, Occupations Code, as
- 15 amended by this Act, apply only to the renewal of a physical
- 16 therapist or physical therapist assistant license that expires on
- 17 or after December 1, 2013. A license that expires before that date
- 18 is governed by the law in effect on the date the license expires,
- 19 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
