 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to certain health programs and councils.  
 1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 533.005(a-1), Government Code, is  
 1-24 amended to read as follows:  
 1-25 (a-1) The requirements imposed by Subsections (a)(23)(A),  
 1-26 (B), and (C) do not apply, and may not be enforced, on and after  
 1-27 August 31, 2018 [~~2013~~].  
 1-28 SECTION 2. (a) Chapters 38, 46, 83, 90, and 91, Health and  
 1-29 Safety Code, are repealed.  
 1-30 (b) Subchapters A and C, Chapter 86, Health and Safety Code,  
 1-31 are repealed.  
 1-32 (c) Sections 86.011 and 86.012, Health and Safety Code, are  
 1-33 repealed.  
 1-34 SECTION 3. (a) On September 1, 2013, the programs and  
 1-35 system established under Chapters 38, 46, 83, 86, 90, and 91, Health  
 1-36 and Safety Code, as the laws existed immediately before the  
 1-37 effective date of this Act, are abolished.  
 1-38 (b) On September 1, 2013, any money remaining in the  
 1-39 tertiary care account is transferred to the general revenue fund  
 1-40 and the account is abolished.  
 1-41 (c) The repeal of Chapter 83, Health and Safety Code, by  
 1-42 this Act does not affect a cause of action that accrued before the  
 1-43 effective date of this Act. A cause of action that accrued before  
 1-44 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect  
 1-45 immediately before that date, and the former law is continued in  
 1-46 effect for that purpose.  
 1-47 SECTION 4. On September 1, 2013:  
 1-48 (1) the advisory council established under Section  
 1-49 86.003, Health and Safety Code, as the law existed immediately  
 1-50 before the effective date of this Act, is abolished;  
 1-51 (2) all property in the custody of the advisory  
 1-52 council is transferred to the Department of State Health Services;  
 1-53 and  
 1-54 (3) all contracts, leases, rights, and obligations of  
 1-55 the advisory council are transferred to the Department of State  
 1-56 Health Services.  
 1-57 SECTION 5. On September 1, 2013:  
 1-58 (1) the advisory committee established under Section  
 1-59 86.012, Health and Safety Code, as the law existed immediately  
 1-60 before the effective date of this Act, is abolished;

2-1 (2) all property in the custody of the advisory  
2-2 committee is transferred to the Department of State Health  
2-3 Services; and

2-4 (3) all contracts, leases, rights, and obligations of  
2-5 the advisory committee are transferred to the Department of State  
2-6 Health Services.

2-7 SECTION 6. On September 1, 2013:

2-8 (1) the advisory council established under Section  
2-9 86.103, Health and Safety Code, as the law existed immediately  
2-10 before the effective date of this Act, is abolished;

2-11 (2) all property in the custody of the advisory  
2-12 council is transferred to the Department of State Health Services;  
2-13 and

2-14 (3) all contracts, leases, rights, and obligations of  
2-15 the advisory council are transferred to the Department of State  
2-16 Health Services.

2-17 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
