4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 1201, Occupations Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 1201.1025 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 1201.1025. EXEMPTION FROM RETAILER'S LICENSE
8	REQUIREMENT. (a) In this section, "qualifying sale" means a sale
9	of two or more manufactured homes that are:
10	(1) considered to be personal property; and
11	(2) sold in a single transaction as part of a
12	manufactured home community as defined by Section 94.001, Property
13	<u>Code.</u>
14	(b) Notwithstanding any other law, in any 12-month period a
15	person is exempt from holding a retailer's license as required by
16	Section 1201.101(b) if during that period the person:
17	(1) makes not more than two qualifying sales; and
18	(2) does not sell any manufactured home other than
19	through those qualifying sales.
20	(c) The department by rule shall develop a form necessary
21	for a person to establish eligibility for the exemption provided by
22	this section.
23	(d) A person who is eligible for an exemption under this
24	section remains subject to the other applicable provisions of this

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## 1 <u>subchapter regarding the sale of manufactured homes.</u>

2 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 3 to the sale of manufactured homes on or after the effective date of 4 this Act. A sale of manufactured homes before that date is governed 5 by the law in effect on the date of the sale, and the former law is 6 continued in effect for that purpose.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
