1 subchapter regarding the sale of manufactured homes.

2 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 3 to the sale of manufactured homes on or after the effective date of 4 this Act. A sale of manufactured homes before that date is governed 5 by the law in effect on the date of the sale, and the former law is 6 continued in effect for that purpose.

7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
