- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 1601.265, Occupations
- 7 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 1601.265. WAIVER OF CERTAIN LICENSE AND CERTIFICATE
- 9 REQUIREMENTS; PERSONAL INTERVIEW.
- SECTION 2. Section 1601.265, Occupations Code, is amended
- 11 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (a-1) and (c) to
- 12 read as follows:
- 13 (a) The department shall issue a license or certificate to
- 14 an applicant for a license or certificate issued under Section
- 15 1601.253, 1601.256, 1601.258, or 1601.259 if the applicant:
- 16 (1) submits an application on a form prescribed by the
- 17 department;
- 18 (2) pays the application fee; and
- 19 (3) provides proof that the applicant holds a current
- 20 license to engage in the same or a similar activity issued by
- 21 another jurisdiction that has license requirements substantially
- 22 equivalent to those of this state.
- 23 (a-1) The department may waive any [license] requirement
- 24 for a license or certificate issued under this chapter, other than a

- 1 <u>license or certificate listed in Subsection (a)</u>, for an applicant
- 2 holding a license from another state or country that has license
- 3 requirements substantially equivalent to those of this state.
- 4 (c) A license or certificate issued under Subsection (a)
- 5 must be renewed as provided by Subchapter I.
- 6 SECTION 3. Subchapter F, Chapter 1602, Occupations Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 1602.268 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 1602.268. WAIVER OF CERTAIN LICENSE REQUIREMENTS. (a)
- 9 The department shall issue a license to an applicant for a license
- 10 issued under Section 1602.254 if the applicant:
- 11 (1) submits an application on a form prescribed by the
- 12 <u>department;</u>
- 13 (2) pays the application fee; and
- 14 (3) provides proof that the applicant holds a current
- 15 license to engage in the same or a similar activity issued by
- 16 another state that has license requirements substantially
- 17 equivalent to those of this state.
- 18 (b) The department may waive any requirement for a license
- 19 or certificate issued under this chapter, other than a license
- 20 listed in Subsection (a), for an applicant holding a license from
- 21 <u>another state that has license requirements substantially</u>
- 22 <u>equivalent to those of this state.</u>
- 23 <u>(c) A license issued under Subsection (a) must be renewed as</u>
- 24 provided by Subchapter H.
- 25 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 26 an application for the issuance of a license or certificate under
- 27 Chapters 1601 and 1602, Occupations Code, as amended by this Act,

- 1 that is filed with the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation
- 2 on or after the effective date of this Act. An application for the
- 3 issuance of a license or certificate that is filed before the
- 4 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 5 date the application was filed, and the former law is continued in
- 6 effect for that purpose.
- 7 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
