1-21 relating to the report by the General Land Office to the legislature
 1-22 on the effectiveness of the coastal management program.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 33.204(f), Natural Resources Code, is
 1-25 amended to read as follows:

1-26 (f) The land office, in coordination with other agencies and
 1-27 subdivisions, shall prepare a biennial [~~an annual~~] report on the
 1-28 effectiveness of the coastal management program. On or before
 1-29 January 15 of each odd-numbered year, the land office shall send the
 1-30 report to the legislature [~~each of the previous two annual~~
 1-31 ~~reports~~].

1-32 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-33 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-34 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-35 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-36 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
