Section 11.1512, Education Code, is amended by adding Subsections (c), (d), (e), and (f) to read as follows: 6 7 (c) A member of the board of trustees of the district, when acting in the member's official capacity, has an inherent right of 8 9 access to information, documents, and records maintained by the district, and the district shall provide the information, 10 documents, and records to the member without requiring the member 11 to submit a public information request under Chapter 552, 12 Government Code. The district shall provide the information, 13 14 documents, and records to the member without regard to whether the requested items are the subject of or relate to an item listed on an 15 16 agenda for an upcoming meeting. The district may withhold or redact information, a document, or a record requested by a member of the 17 board to the extent that the item is excepted from disclosure or is 18 confidential under Chapter 552, Government Code, or other law. 19 This subsection does not require the district to provide 20 information, documents, and records that are not subject to 21 disclosure under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 22 23 1974 (20 U.S.C. Section 1232g). 24 (d) A school district shall post, in a place convenient to

- of responding to requests under Subsection (c).
