5	SECTION 1. Sections 171.024(b), (c), and (d), Election
6	Code, are amended to read as follows:
7	(b) <u>A</u> [ <del>Except as provided by Subsection (c), a</del> ] majority of
8	the committee's membership must participate in filling a vacancy <u>in</u>
9	the office of county chair. To be elected, a person must receive a
10	favorable vote of a majority of the members voting.
11	(c) Each party shall adopt rules to provide for the filling
12	of a $[A]$ vacancy in the office of precinct chair $[may be filled]$
13	without participation of the majority of the committee membership
14	if only one person is a candidate to fill the vacancy and the
15	<del>person:</del>
16	[ <del>(1) was elected as a precinct chair in the most recent</del>
17	primary election in the county; and
18	[ <del>(2) is eligible to serve in the vacant office</del> ].
19	(d) A vacancy in the office of county chair may not be filled
20	before the beginning of the term of office in which the vacancy
21	occurs.
22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
23	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
24	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
