- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 501, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 501.023 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 501.023. VERIFICATION OF INMATE VETERAN STATUS. (a)
- 8 In this section, "system" means the Public Assistance Reporting
- 9 Information System (PARIS) operated by the Administration for
- 10 Children and Families of the United States Department of Health and
- 11 <u>Human Services.</u>
- 12 (b) The department shall:
- 13 (1) investigate and verify the veteran status of each
- 14 inmate by using data made available from the system through the
- 15 Health and Human Services Commission; and
- 16 (2) use system data to assist inmates who are veterans
- 17 in applying for federal benefits or compensation for which the
- 18 inmates may be eligible under a program administered by the United
- 19 States Department of Veterans Affairs.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
