- 5 SECTION 1. Section 51.805(a), Education Code, is amended to

- 7 (a) A graduating student who does not qualify for admission
- 8 under Section 51.803 or 51.804 may apply to any general academic
- 9 teaching institution if the student [satisfies the requirements
- 10 of]:
- 11 (1) satisfies the requirements of [Section
- 12 51.803(a)(2)(A) or 51.803(b), as applicable to the student, or
- 13 Section 51.803(a)(2)(B); or [and]
- 14 (2) successfully completes a public or private high
- 15 school curriculum that the institution considers satisfactory in
- 16 content and rigor and provides to the institution a high school
- 17 transcript or diploma reflecting that the student has completed or
- 18 is on schedule to complete that curriculum [Sections 51.803(c)(2)
- 19  $\frac{\text{and } 51.803(d)}{\text{and } 51.803(d)}$ ].
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 21 51.805, Education Code, applies beginning with the 2013 fall
- 22 semester.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
