- 20 not required to comply with the continuing education requirements

- 22 added by this Act, for any continuing education requirements period
- 23 that ends before January 1, 2017.
- 24 SECTION 4. An educator subject to continuing education
- 25 requirements immediately before the effective date of this Act is
- 26 not required to comply with the continuing education requirements
- 27 described by Section 21.054(g), Education Code, as added by this

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- 1 Act, for any continuing education requirements period that ends
- 2 before January 1, 2016.
- 3 SECTION 5. This Act applies beginning with the 2014-2015
- 4 school year.
- 5 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
