- 2 relating to the requirements for members appointed to the Texas

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 501.051, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (a-1) One of the members appointed under Subsection (a)(1)
- 8 or (a)(2) must practice as a licensed specialist in school
- 9 psychology under Section 501.260.
- 10 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act in the
- 11 qualifications of members of the Texas State Board of Examiners of
- 12 Psychologists do not affect the entitlement of a member serving on
- 13 the board immediately before the effective date of this Act to
- 14 continue to serve for the remainder of the member's term. As the
- 15 terms of board members expire, the governor shall appoint or
- 16 reappoint a member who has the qualifications required for a member
- 17 under Section 501.051(a-1), Occupations Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
