- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 392.0331(f) and (f-1), Local Government
- 6 Code, are repealed.
- 7 SECTION 2. The repeal by this Act of Sections 392.0331(f)
- 8 and (f-1), Local Government Code, applies to a commissioner
- 9 appointed under Section 392.0331, Local Government Code, without
- 10 regard to whether the commissioner was appointed before, on, or
- 11 after the effective date of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
