5	SECTION 1. Chapter 86, Election Code, is amended by adding
6	Section 86.0015 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 86.0015. APPLYING FOR MORE THAN ONE ELECTION IN SAME
8	APPLICATION. (a) This section applies only to an application for a
9	ballot to be voted by mail that:
10	(1) is submitted to the county clerk indicating the
11	ground of eligibility is age or disability; and
12	(2) does not specify the election for which a ballot is
13	requested.
14	(b) An application described by Subsection (a) is
15	considered to be an application for a ballot for each election in
16	which the county clerk serves as early voting clerk and:
17	(1) in which the applicant is eligible to vote; and
18	(2) that occurs before the first anniversary of the
19	date the application was submitted.
20	(c) An application described by Subsection (a) shall be
21	preserved for the period for preserving the precinct election
22	records for the last election for which the application is
23	effective.
24	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only

1 to an application for a ballot to be voted by mail received on or 2 after the effective date of this Act.

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2014.
