AN ACT

- 2 relating to the first day of instruction at a public school.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 25.0811(a), Education Code, is amended 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (a) Except as provided by this section, a school district
- 7 may not begin instruction for students for a school year before the
- 8 week [fourth Monday] in which August 21 falls. For the purposes of
- 9 this subsection, Sunday is considered the first day of the week. A
- 10 school district may:
- 11 (1) begin instruction for students for a school year
- 12 before the week [fourth Monday] in which August 21 falls if the
- 13 district operates a year-round system under Section 25.084; or
- 14 (2) begin instruction for students for a school year
- 15 on or after the first Monday in August at a campus or at not more
- 16 than 20 percent of the campuses in the district if:
- 17 (A) the district has a student enrollment of
- 18 190,000 or more;
- 19 (B) the district at the beginning of the school
- 20 year provides, financed with local funds, days of instruction for
- 21 students at the campus or at each of the multiple campuses, in
- 22 addition to the minimum number of days of instruction required
- 23 under Section 25.081;
- (C) the campus or each of the multiple campuses

- 1 are undergoing comprehensive reform, as determined by the board of
- 2 trustees of the district; and
- 3 (D) a majority of the students at the campus or at
- 4 each of the multiple campuses are educationally disadvantaged.
- 5 SECTION 2. (a) Section 25.0811(a), Education Code, as
- 6 amended by this Act, applies beginning with the 2014-2015 school
- 7 year.
- 8 (b) This Act does not affect the validity of a waiver issued
- 9 under Section 7.056, Education Code, that applies to the first day
- 10 of instruction for the 2014-2015 or a subsequent school year.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
