The notice may be served by its deposit in the municipality, properly addressed with postage paid, in the United 13 14 States mail. (c-2) Subsection (c-1) does not apply to a municipality the 15 16 majority of which is located in a county with a population of 100,000 or less, except that such a municipality must give notice 17 under Subsection (c-1) to a school district that has territory in 18 19 the municipality and requests the notice. For purposes of this subsection, if a school district makes a request for notice under 20 21 Subsection (c-1), the municipality must give notice of each public hearing held following the request unless the school district 22 23 requests that no further notices under Subsection (c-1) be given to the school district. 24

- SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to a proposal to change a municipal zoning classification made on or after the effective date of this Act. A proposal to change a municipal zoning classification made before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the time the proposal was made, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
